

**Proposed Four County Players bylaws amendment establishing term limits to be ratified by the membership at the Four County Players Annual Meeting, June 15, 2020**

**Section 3: Terms of Office.** A Director shall serve a three-year term. Up to one-third (1/3) of the Board, excluding the Youth Representative, shall be elected each year to serve such three-year terms. The term of a Youth Representative automatically expires on June 30 following his/her eighteenth (18th) birthday. **Directors may be elected by the Membership for no more than two consecutive terms or consecutive partial terms. A Director who has rotated off the board after two consecutive terms is eligible to stand for election again after a one-year hiatus. This term limit provision goes into effect on July 1, 2020, and everyone currently serving on the board on that date will be considered to be in their first term for term limit purposes.**

**Section 4: Vacancies.** If the office of a Director becomes vacant for any reason, the Directors may elect a successor in accordance with Article VIII to complete the unexpired term. **Former Directors who rotated off the Board because of term limits are eligible for appointment in this manner, regardless of whether a year has passed since leaving the Board.**

*Therefore:*

*Directors elected or reelected in 2020 must rotate off in 2026.*

*Directors elected or reelected in 2019 must rotate off in 2025.*

*Directors elected or reelected in 2018 must rotate off in 2024.*
